1 The Court has received and considered the motions of Plaintiff ERIC FELIX
2 (“Plaintiff”) for preliminary and final approval of the Class Action Settlement
3 Agreement and Release (“Settlement” or “Agreement”) entered into between
4 Plaintiff ERIC FELIX, an individual (“Plaintiff”), on behalf of himself, and on
5 behalf of all persons similarly situated, and Defendant WM. BOLTHOUSE
6 FARMS, INC. (“Defendant”), and has entered the Order for final approval of the
7 Settlement.

8 **NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:**

9 1. The Court, having entered an order granting Final Approval of this
10 Settlement, hereby enters FINAL JUDGMENT in accordance with and incorporates
11 by reference, the findings of the Court’s Orders and the Parties’ Class Action Release
12 and Settlement Agreement (“Settlement Agreement”).

13 2. The Parties shall bear their own costs and attorneys’ fees except as
14 otherwise provided by the Settlement Agreement and the Final Approval Order.

15 3. With the exception of the two Class Members who opted out of the
16 Settlement Class, all Class Members, including Plaintiff, are bound by this Judgment
17 and are barred from pursuing, or seeking to reopen, any of the Released Claims, as
18 defined in the Settlement Agreement.

19 4. This document shall constitute a Final Judgment for purposes of Fed.
20 R. Civ. P. Rule 58. This Judgment is intended to be a final disposition of the above-
21 captioned action in its entirety.

22 5. This action is dismissed with prejudice, each side to bear its own costs
23 and attorneys’ fees except as provided by the Settlement Agreement and the Final
24 Approval Order.

25 6. Without affecting the finality of this Judgment, the Court retains
26 jurisdiction for purposes of enforcing the terms of the Judgment entered herein.
